REGULAR BOARD OF ALDERMEN MEETING

November 18, 2025

Mayor Roberson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL FOR ALDERMEN IN ATTENDANCE: B. Hull, Hull, Muller, Williams (Walker arrived 7:04)

PUBLIC IN ATTENDANCE: Haider Nawaz, Bryce Smith of Waste Management

CITY EMPLOYEES IN ATTENDANCE: City Clerk Nawaz, Chief of Police Vick

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: Recited by all in presence.

CONSENT AGENDA:

- 1. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF OCTOBER 21, 2025**
- 2. REVIEW OF THE EXPENSE REPORT (Attachment 1)**

Mayor Roberson asked for comments and questions for the consent agenda. Alderman Hull questioned the GL entry of an expense that should be in Equipment instead of Office supplies. Mayor will address it with the Accounting Clerk. No other questions or objections were stated; the consent agenda was unanimously approved.

NEW BUSINESS:

Waste Management (WM): Mayor Roberson stated that at the last meeting Board approved a 5-year contract with Waste Management. A draft of contract was shared via email with the Board for questions or comments. Some questions were asked; Bryce Smith, present in public, responded:

- Bulk item size (4'x4'x2') mentioned in the draft contract is due to the regulations for the automated truck's pickup capacity; Smith mentioned that larger items (i.e., couches and mattresses) will still be picked up and crushed to fit.
- Roll Out period duration to be determined; customers will not be charged contamination or overage charges during the Roll Out period,
- Customer education program will be provided by WM to minimize the instances of contamination and overage. Following the Roll Out period, the contaminated recycling bins will not be picked up, two initial notices will be followed up with a contamination fee charged at the third occurrence. Contamination fees will be added to Exhibit A,
- Working on customer call system to make it efficient and user friendly.
- Working on 2026 trash pickup calendar,
- Ambiguity, if any, will be corrected in the contract.

The Mayor, Board members and City Clerk thanked Bryce Smith for his availability to answer questions and improve customer service issues. Bryce Smith left at 7:20 p.m.

Regional HHW Collection Program Participation--2026 Agreement

Mayor Roberson read aloud the participation fee data (attachment 2). City's membership provides the residents access to two permanent facilities and multiple mobile events for disposal of household hazardous waste.

Alderman Muller moved to approve 2026 Intergovernmental Agreement with the MARC Solid Waste Management District. Participation fee in the amount of \$733.02 to be paid upon receipt of the invoice. Seconded by Alderman Williams. Motion passed unanimously.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Snow Removal Bid/Contract for 2025/2026

City received only one bid. The bid was turned in by last year's contractor Bob Bazin of G-B Construction, LLC (attachment3). The bid was shared in advance with the Board via email.

Alderman Walker moved to approve the snow removal bid presented by G-B Construction, LLC, for the year 2025-2026 snow season. Seconded by Alderman Muller. Motion passed unanimously.

VA1- 2025—Setback Variance 319 W. Walnut Street, Lot B, Original Town Street: Mayor Roberson informed that at the public hearing on October 23, 2025, the Board of Adjustment has approved the setback variance for the property located at 319 W. Walnut Street; adjusted the front setback to 25 feet and the rear set back to 20 feet. (attachment 4).

REPORT OF OFFICERS—MEMBERS—COMMITTEES

Alderman Walker: Nothing to report currently.

Alderman Williams: Stated that a Lazy Y resident had asked him about the regulations for the keeping of chickens. Discussion held about the regulations of the City's Animal Code; Lazy Y covenants and enforcement of the same by the Lazy Y architectural committee. Discussion held about the process of suspending the covenants. Alderman Muller stated that it depends on how the covenants were written; usually it involves a petition followed by a legal process. Alderman Muller will look further into it.

Alderman B. Hull: Reported:

1. The South 3rd Streets speed humps have been scraped down; due to the gradual sloping they are less aggressive. The speed hump between Walnut Street and Mulberry Street is still a little

high; so far, no complaints have been received for it. Mayor Roberson informed that he will be following up to get the said speed humps painted.

2. Alderman B. Hull informed that the recent construction at Walnut Street & 4th Street has caused street fatigue, commonly known as alligator cracking. Discussion held about including Walnut, Mulberry and 4th Streets to the next phase of street repairs.

Alderman Muller: Reported:

1. Rolled over another CD in the amount of \$75,000 at the rate of 3.750% with Wells Fargo Bank.
2. Above Standard Recycling (ASR) of Westline has informed that he would like to do another city-wide recycling event in Cleveland this Spring or Summer; he will contact the City to schedule it.
3. Working on two wooden deer and two tree cutouts for the Main Street holiday decorations.

Holiday Lighting Event : Mayor Roberson informed that the Holiday Lighting Ceremony will be held on Saturday, November 29, 2025. Mayor Roberson stated that City staff has been busy getting ready for the event and everything is coming together nicely.

Alderman Hull: Asked if City would be identifying a couple of struggling families to help them with the Thanksgiving and holiday season. Alderman Muller suggested to contact local churches. Alderman Walker informed that Faith Chapel in Louisburg can be contacted; they do provide help for the struggling families. Mayor Roberson suggested to ask the local school as well.

Chief Vick Informed:

1. Seargent Shepherdson is getting enlisted in US Army to become a reserve and for training purposes; he will be off from City's employment for a period of five (5) months.
2. Chief Vick informed that he hopes to hire Gary Kerley, a former officer who worked with Grandview Police Department for fifteen years. Chief Vick informed that due to the break in his employment, Kerley will have to get his POST certification renewed. Chief informed that Kerley filled out the employment application today and hopes to be able to get POST certified soon. Chief Vick will introduce Kerley to the Board in December after he completes the POST certification.
3. Chief Vick informed that both police vehicles have the Central Square system's computers installed; one vehicle has the printer installed too. Currently electronic citations have a glitch with numbering system; citations are still getting handwritten until the glitch is fixed. Sheriff's Office and Traffic Department are very helpful with answering the questions about the said system.
4. Chief Vick reported that his department might have identified the suspect of recent break-ins of the storage units.

5. Chief Vick stated that lately some offenders have been very irate with him and are complaining because he is doing his job. Mayor Roberson stated that he has received a written complaint and a phone call complaint. Mayor Roberson stated that he knows Chief Vick is doing his job properly but to protect him and the citizens he has asked Chief Vick to get body cam bids. Discussion held.

Election Filing: City Clerk informed that filing for April 7, 2026, Municipal Elections opens on Tuesday, December 9, 2025. Closing date for the filing will be Tuesday, December 30, 2025.

Mayor Roberson: Informed:

1. City's Trunk O' Treat event was very successful; a food truck was present for the event and approximately 70 kids came for Trick O' Treating.
2. Mayor Roberson has contacted Peculiar and Belton about their procedure for locates. Belton has good GIS system and a dedicated position for locates and they have a machine for locates; Mayor will follow up for further information.
3. Mayor has talked to City's Water/Sewer Superintendent Maynard about the possibility of renting a GPR (Ground Penetrating Radar) machine to locate the missing lines. Missouri Rural Water Association (MRWA) would help with that.
4. Mayor Roberson has reached out to a former State Representative to discuss options to increase the working hours stipulation for the Missouri Local Government Employees Retirement System (LAGERS).



ADJOURNMENT: Alderman Hull moved to adjourn at 8:02 pm. Seconded by Alderman Williams. Motion passed unanimously.


